1. Introduction

The Pupil Wallet website located on www.pupilwallet.com ("Site") and the Pupil Wallet Mobile Applications ("App") available on Apple App Store (IOS) and Google Play Store (Android), are owned and operated by Pupil Wallet from the United Kingdom. Throughout the Site, the terms "we", "us", "platform", and "our" refer to Pupil Wallet. We offer the Pupil Wallet Site and App, including all information, tools, and services available from this site to you, the user, conditioned upon your acceptance of all terms, conditions, policies, and notices stated here.

By visiting our site and/or when using our App, you ("User") engage in our "Services" and agree to be bound by the following terms and conditions ("Terms"), including those additional terms and conditions and policies referenced herein and/or available by hyperlink. These Terms and Conditions apply to all users of the Site and App including without limitation users who are browsers, pupils of schools, general users, and/or contributors of content.

2. General Information

- About. Pupil Wallet is an integrated payment system designed for schools. It eliminates
 the need for physical cash and cards within communities by digitising payments through
 a cloud-based system. Pupil Wallet runs off of two mobile applications, one for pupils
 and parents and another for vendors. For more information on the products and

- **Sole discretion.** We reserve the right to add/discontinue any product or service anytime at the sole discretion and without notice.

3. App Updates and Functionality

From time to time, updates to the App may be made available through the App Store and Play Store. Depending on the update, and whether you utilized the App Store or Play Store to download and access the App, you may not be able to use the App until you have installed the latest version. In addition, you acknowledge that the App is provided over the Internet and mobile networks and so the quality and availability of the App may be affected by factors outside our reasonable control. Accordingly, we do not accept any responsibility for any connectivity issues that you may experience when using the App. In addition, you acknowledge and agree that you (and not us) are responsible for obtaining and maintaining all telecommunications,

broadband and computer hardware, equipment and services needed to access and use the App, and for paying any data charges that may be charged to you by your network provider in connection with your use of the App.

4. Store Rules

With respect to downloading the App, you agree to comply with the App Store Rules and Play Store Rules, as applicable. 8. General Conditions

- **Student.** The pupil app displays the user's profile, balance and transaction history whilst allowing them to top up their account via the deposit button. Students can then pay for items around the college by scanning their QR code or by giving their name to the vendor, who then verifies the pupil's account before completing the transaction.
- Parent. The parent portal allows for more insight into their pupil's spending around the
 college. Parents can monitor their children's transaction history, restrict spending at
 various college shops, deposit money directly into their account, and be notified instantly
 of any charges being added to the school bill.
- **Vendor.** We provide vendors with a point of sale (POS) system free of charge. It runs off of an alternate application that allows them to charge pupil accounts for items that they sell, such as food, clothing, and stationery. Pupil Wallet's POS system was built in-house and is tailored specifically for use with our Pupil Wallet App.

• **School.** The Dashboard can be accessed by designated staff. The software is webbased and enables full autonomy over the school's monetary system. Administrators have access to: individual pupil transaction history, accounts for college vendors, and the ability to restrict or reward year groups or individual users.

9. Refunds & Cancellations

To initiate cancellation or terminate the contract, the School must send us a notice of intimation at least 1 month before the termination. Any refunds must be requested via the App.

10. Intellectual Property Rights
